Govt. Degree College Baldwara came into existence with the notification of Govt. of Himachal Pradesh on 24th Feb. 2014, with a vision to provide education to far flung areas of Baldwara Tehsil.

Today we are celebrating our 5th Annual Prize Distribution Function & we know that annual function is an event that celebrates the Achievements & Accomplishments of an Institution. It is an opportunity to showcase the talents of our students & to recognize their efforts. Presently we are offering education in threestreams: Science, Arts & Commerce to our students.

In the beginning of college, only Arts stream was started ,but later on keeping in view the larger interest of local students, Commerce & Science stream were introduced in the year 2016 & 2022 respectively. After completion of a decade, we now have ample space in terms of class rooms and also for organizing various other activities.
