## **Best Practices of the College in 2024-25**

### **1. Preservation of historical Lord Shiva temple in the college campus.**

In this session 2024-25, like previous year we continued our tradition to Protect, preserve and renovate the temple and other samadhis present in our college premises. Like last year Dr. Nancee, A.P. Commerce, played very vital role in the renovation work of Lord Shiva temple. The floor of the temple was in very bad condition, so it was renovated by installing new tiles both inside the temple as well as the outer platform of temple. She also borne the decoration charges of temple on the occasion of Mahashivratri and Diwali. So Principal Prof. Vijay Kaundal ji honored her on the occasion of annual function and praised her for her devotion and affection towards this temple.

This temple is very old temple and people of nearby villages perform their daily pooja rituals and also celebrate the special occasions like Mahashivratri and Diwali .They also perform some other Sanatan Dharma rituals in these premises. On 10th October 2024, Dr. Ashok Kumar Pathania , Assistant Professor English at GDC Sarkaghat and deputed at GDC Baldwara organized a community lunch (Bhandara) to the students and staff of GDC Baldwara on fulfillment of his special wish by Lord Shiva.

This year we also got the opportunity to witness the special custom of Himachali marriage called "Peepal – Poojan". On 6<sup>th</sup> May 2025, there was a marriage in the surrounding village Khudla and at 11:00 am the whole village people along with the Bride & Bridegroom entered the college premises. They performed the ritual of Peepal Poojan and then Old ladies sang their tradional marriage songs and young Boys started dancing on the tunes of band party.

Our college is committed to preserve this historical temple & other monuments in near future also. So we hope that the good work of renovation, maintenance & preservation will remain continue in next year.



#### **4. THE PRACTICE:--** As mentioned above that the main motto

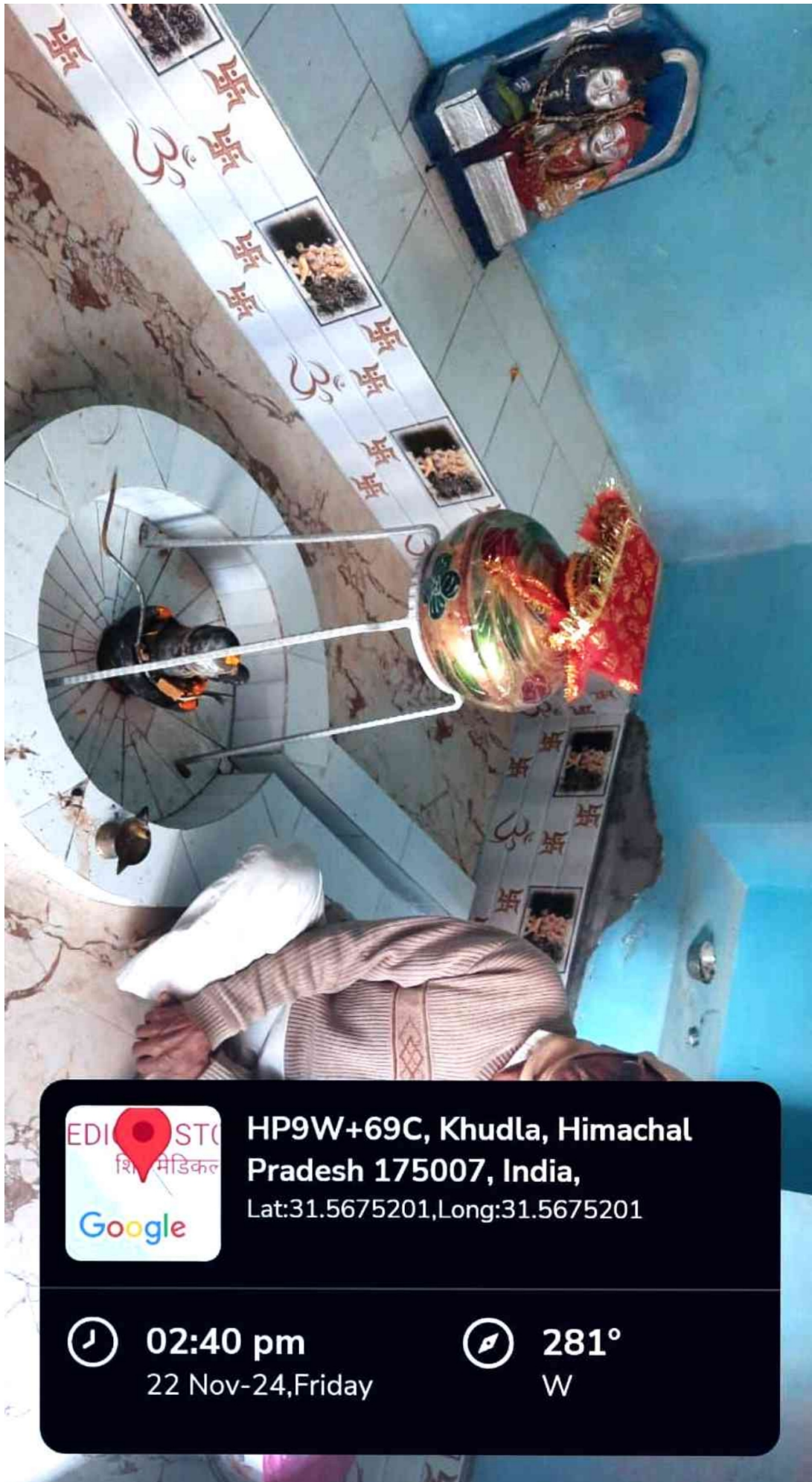
#### **6. Problems Encountered & Resources Required : ---**
